

Short Study 31: Biblical Symbols 5 - Fire

Read Luke 12:49-53

There are 424 references to *fire* in the Bible. Most occurrences are literal, but many times the word is used metaphorically, illustrating a variety of different things.

Below is a list of ten things that are symbolised by fire, with examples of where they can be found. Choose as many of them as time allows, read the suggested verses. Then, using a concordance, see if you can find some other references where the symbol of fire is used in similar ways.

Psalm 89:46 Anger Careless talk James 3:5. Destruction Psalm 18:8. God's alory Ezek 1:4,13. Acts 2:13. The Holy Spirit Jealousy Zeph 3:8. Judgment/Hell Rev 20:15. Quality control 1 Cor 3:13. Sanctification Rev 3:18. Suffering Psalm 66:12.

To think about: In Leviticus 10 v 1 we read that the sons of Aaron *offered profane fire before the Lord* (NIV *unauthorised fire*; Heb. *zuwr* ='strange'). What do you think this means, and what are the implications for us today?

To dig deeper: In Luke 12:49, Jesus says he "I came to send fire on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled!" Read what the commentator say about this statement.
